## Background

Born in Dublin, a predominantly commercial, but beautiful city of parks and historic sites left largely untouched by the havoc of Earth's chaotic past.

The second of three children to Ann, an elementary school teacher and William, an assistant grounds keeper for the principal of Dublin's parks: Phoenix Park. Mary, his eldest sister, is three years older; Linda is two years younger.

Having a quite life growing up, James spent considerable amounts of time with his parents. Raised to cherish his Gaelic heritage, James is very familiar with his native language, culture and history. Although they share a close relationship, James did not share his mothers' interest in teaching. Rather than follow in her footsteps as she had hoped, James pursued his interest of medicine.

At seventeen James entered Pre-Med, attending Glasgow University. Always somewhat introverted, James did not make friends quickly. Often described by his peers as a "stubborn Irishman," which he is. After completing the two year course James entered medical collage, returning home to attend the University of Dublin.

In the second of his four years at University, James' father passed away. This loss had a profound affect on James. His grades started to suffer, doing just well enough on projects to skate by, however, he soon found himself on the verge of expulsion. But one of his professors, Patrick Collins, recognized James' potential and over the course of the remaining semester helped James focus on his studies and get back on track. To this day James and Collins are very close.

Completing medical school the year after the Cardassian withdraw from Bajor, the plight of the Bajoran people was always in the forethought of the student body thanks to natural youthful activism. James was no different. He applied for, and was accepted, an internship with the Bajoran Health Ministry. James would spend the year assigned to the Elemspur Medical Annex on Bajor. Once the site of a Cardassian detention center during the occupation, it is now part of the Ilvian Medical Complex; studying (and treating) the health concerns caused by the occupation.

Shortly after his arrival, James met Bajoran Councilor Derna Beka. In a very short time she had become very important to him, and during the year they were seldom apart from one another. Reaching the end of his internship, James and two decisions to make. Before leaving Bajor, James presented Beka with a betrothal bracelet which she happily accepted. Eighteen months after first meeting they were married in a ceremony in Dublin. Five months latter, Beka gave birth to triplets: two boys and a girl.

Seeing the role Starfleet was playing in aiding Bajoran recovery, and after much consideration and thought; James decided to join Starfleet and spent four months at Starfleet Academy in preparation for his service in the fleet. While at the Academy, James demanded perfection of himself and anyone working with him and can be very difficult to work with. He can, however, be very charming if he wants to be; and is always very friendly towards his patients. Completing Officer Candidate School, James spent his two year residency at Bethesda Fleet Hospital, Terra.

Once his residency was completed, James requested assignment to Bajor to rejoin his wife and the staff of the Elemspur Medical Annex. However, the request was not granted and James was assigned as a medical officer to the hospital ship USS *Nightingale*, his first starship posting. Beka, living on Terra since the marriage, has returned to Bajor pending approval of her posting to *Nightingale* as family of a crew member. Beka is seeking the accreditation to serve Starfleet as a Council and receiver formal posting to *Nightingale* as a crew member.
