



MOLNA, ARCTURIAN

Description and Notes

One of the few surviving native species of Arcturus. This aquatic fish is a bottom-feeder, their poor eyesight is supplemented by four barbels hanging from the chin. Feeding on small marine animals and their eggs, small prey is caught by two armed barbels extending from above the mouth. Respiration is performed by a pair of four gills on either side of the head, just behind a double pair of small eyes. The mouth contain a few teeth, the largest of which are on the armed barbels and used to grasp prey and convey it to the mouth.

Special/Unusual Skills

Molna have very poor vision, defined as the Poor Sight (-2) disadvantage.

Form: Broad mouth and barbels, two large "wing" fins, two small paddle fins, and four small eyes.
